GEO. CUMMINGS, farmer, P. O. Antioch Mills, is a native of Harrison Co., KY, and son of Joseph and Lydia (Fleming) Cummings. He was born Aug. 8, 1810. His father was a native of Maryland. When quite young he moved with his parents to Bourbon Co., KY, who were among the earlier settlers. He was then married to Lydia Fleming, who bore him thirteen children, all of whom are now living and having large families of their own. He followed farming to the time of his death, which occurred in 1833, aged eighty-seven years. His wife died in 1824, aged fifty years. Geo. Cummings lived his earlier life with his parents, working on the farm and hunting. In 1831 he married Sarah Adams, who was a native of Harrison Co., KY She was born in 1808 and died in 1866. She bore him thirteen children, seven of whom are living, viz: Joseph F., Catharine E., Lydia M., Sarah J., John Robert and Thomas. He bought his farm in 1835, still continuing the management of it. In 1875 he again married to Sarah McLaughlin, who has borne him one child, Anna W. He has a farm of 343 acres, raising all the principal crops, making tobacco a specialty. During his younger days he took great delight and made great success in hunting; he is a member of the Christian Church; he is a Democrat.

The old Cummins homesite may also serve as a family cemetery. Eugene Bower, in his family history, Joseph Cummins Family, 1793-1995, writes that in 1942 "Robert Huffman . . . a grand nephew of George Cummins, stated in the E.E. Barton files . . . the following. 'George Cummins. . . is buried in the family grave yard on his farm, up on a hill back of the old house'" and that "there is no gravestone in Antioch Mills Cemetery with his name or dates on it. There is one with his first wife, Sarah's name and dates on it. Therefore, it may be that George Cummins was buried on his farm with the two un-named children and his daughter Mary Ann whose positive burial place is unknown."

The final resting place for many of George Cummins' family and descendants is across the road and up the hill from the log house beside the three cedars. It would appear that George's parents are also buried there, as the following account found in the E.E. Barton Papers regarding the establishment of Antioch Mills Cemetery records:

"Antioch burying ground is on a low hill overlooking the village, where Joseph and wife were buried. It is a tradition that Joseph and wife were returning from over on Snake Lick, about 3 miles, and stopped walking home, she stop[p]ed on this hill to rest, seating herself on a log. The place so impressed her, (that) she remarked that when she died she wanted to be buried there. Her wish was carried out and was the starting of a village burying ground."

Aaron Adams, a native of Massachusetts, was born about 1770. He ca me to KY in the late 1780's possilby with John Adams (relationship unknown), a large land owner in Bourbon County.

He first appeared on the Pendleton County, Ky tax rolls in 1800. Aaron Ad ams was married Stepmber 26, 1805 in Pendleton County, Ky to Jean Resq ue Steward, 'both having been formerly married.'

Aaron Adams was a resident of Grant County, Ky in 1820 when Grant County w as created out of the western part of Pendleton County. In the Census tak en that year, his family was reported to consist of two males under age 1 0, one male between 16 and 16, one male between 18 and 25, one male betwe en 26 and 45, five females under 10 and 16 and one female between 26 and 4 5.

Aaron Adams served in the Indian war known as St. Clairs War and was wound ed on November 6, 1792. In his record under Old Wars Invalid File 2444 6, he was awarded a pension in 1819, the benefit being increased in 183 1. In an undated letter written after 1852, he requested for the second t ime that he be transferred from the Kentucky Roll of Pensions to that of t he State of Missouri where he now resides and that all communications be a ddressed to Union Corners, Van Buren County, IA. H e died in Missou ri in Mary, 1856

The Harrison County application of Aaron Adams is merely mentions th at he had served in the Revolution. He was granted a pension in recogniti on of his service in the St. Clair War of 1792. He suffered a disabling gu nshot wound in the right thigh by a ball, entering on the outside about s ix inches above the knee, injuring the bone seriously and making its ex it about one inch lower on the inside. About 1852 he moved to the vicini ty of Union Corners, Van Buren County, Iowa.

I, John Adair of the County of Harrison and State of Kentucky, do hereby c ertify that in the year 1792, General James Wilkinson, then a Colonel in t he Unites State service, did authorize me to enlist one hundred men in Ken tucky and command them as a captain for three months in the United Stat es service northwest of the Ohio, that I made the enlistment, that Aaron A dams, then a youth, was one of the men so enlisted by me and did perform h is duty faithfully as a soldier, until on the 6th day of November in the y ear 1792, when in the actual discharge of his duty in an action with the In dians near Fort St. Clair he received a gunshot wound in the thigh, when t he tour of service ended he was left in charge of the United States physic ians at Cincinnati by order of said Colonel James Wilkinson until his wou nd was cured or healed, which wound it appears has and does disable him fr om earning his living by his labor. Given under my hand the 12th day of Au gust 1820. Signed: John Adair, Captain then in service of the United State s.

State of Kentucky, County of Harrison.

This day came Aaron Adams before me, a justice of the peace for the coun ty aforesaid, and made oath that heretofore he obtained from the War Offi ce of the United States a pension certificate for a pension of \$72 a ye ar on account of a wound received by him while in the line of his du ty in the actual service of the United States since the Revolutionary Wa r, and that said certificate has been lost or mislaid, so that he cannot f ind the same. Given under my hand this 2nd day of December 1835. Signed T h. B Woodyard.

Payable on the 4th of March and the 4th of September at Lexington by Jo hn Tilford, Pension Agent registered in Book F, Volume 9, Page 1, by D. Br own, Clerk. I certify the written to be a true copy of my certificate giv en the 7th day of May 1832. Aaron (X) Adams.

Secretary of Interior:

Dear Sir, having written to you some time last spring requesting a chan ge from the agency of Kentucky to that of Missouri and having heard nothi ng from you and being in much need, I again address you wishing you to att end to it in haste. I am an old, helpless soldier and have changed my resi dence from Kentucky to Missouri, therefore I request my pension paid in Mi ssouri. I have not received a payment since the fourth of March 1852. Y ou will please give notice immediately of what will be done.

Aaron Adams - Old War Invalid File #24446. Saint Clarr's War. Not in the R evolutionary War. On October 21, 1819 in Frankfort, Kentucky, A. J. Mitchell and Joseph Scot t, both physicians, certify that Aaron Adams, a soldier in the compa ny of Captain John Adams on the Kentucky Militia in the service of the Uni ted States in the year 1792, was rendered incapable of performing the du ty of a soldier by reason of a wound inflicted when he was actually in t he service of the aforesaid and in the line of his duty. On November 6, 17 92, being engaged in an action with the Indians near Fort Saint Clai r, he received a gun shot would in the right thigh and about four inches a bove the knee and he is thereby rendered one-half disabled.

Richard Taylor certifies to Aaron Adams being wounded November 6, 179 2, he the deponent being wounded the the same action at Fort Sinclair on t he same morning. On April 14, 1835, G. H. Perrin and A. T. McMillin, bei ng both physicians, certify that the disability of Aaron Adams is total.

Aaron Adams writes to the Secretary of the Interior, but there is no date given, but it is after 1852, and in this letter he requests for the second time that he be transferred from the Kentucky Roll of Pensions to that of the State of Missouri, saying that he now resides in Missouri, but he asks that all communications be sent to Union Corners at VanBuren County in the State of Iowa.

In Pendleton County, April 19, 1820, Wm. Barnes makes oath to his personal knowledge of the service and wound of Aaron Adams. On December 11, 1830, Joel C. Frazer and Daniel Holt, both practicing physicians, certify that Aaron Adams is three quarters disabled. He is inscribed on the Kentucky Roll of Pensions at the rate of \$4 per annum to commence August 14, 1820.

This pension was later increased to \$8 per month to commence December 24, 1831. John Adair, late Captain, testifies on August 12, 1820 that Aaron Adams was in his company of one hundred men which he enlisted on authorization of General Wilkerson, then his Colonel. He also testifies that Aaron Adams was at that time still a youth. He in addition testifies that he performed his duty faithfully until November 6, 1792 when he was wounded and that at that time he was left in charge of the U. S. Physicians at Cincinnati, in the State of Ohio, by the command of Colonel James Wilkerson.

Note: Aaron was wounded in the S. Clair Indian Wars in 1792. There is a hand-me-down story that the Stephens were somehow related to John Quincy Adams. This would be through Aaron Adams.

He is a brother of James and John Forsythe who came to Chester County, in 1739, and may be closely related to a couple of Ohio Forsythe families. He married Elizabeth Johnson. There were 11 children, the first 8 were born in Chester County, Pennsylvania, and the next 3 in Harford County, Maryland. (The note that Jacob #5 was born in Ireland is unexplained, it might properly apply to his wife.) William purchased the land in Pennsylvania from the Indians for 2 cows, a bushel of salt and a gun in 1769. He built a stone house facing the Monongohela River in 1775. The house is still standing and title to the land has never left the family. It was owned in 1985 by Joseph Bailey Forsythe.
